Iberdrola Energía Internacional and the companies that are part of its group in accordance with commercial legislation undertake to protect your privacy and guarantee compliance with the legislation on the protection of personal data, in particular, the General Data Protection Regulation and the personal data protection legislation applicable in each country in which the companies of its group are domiciled. Your personal data will be treated in a lawful, fair and transparent manner; in accordance with specified explicit and legitimate purposes; only if they are adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary in relation to those purposes. In addition, we will keep your data accurate and up-to-date, keeping it in a way that allows its identification only for the time necessary to fulfill the purposes of the treatment. Iberdrola Energía Internacional has implemented the technical and organizational measures necessary to protect your data from accidental loss or from unauthorized alteration, access, use or disclosure, having also established procedures to react to any security incident that could affect your personal data.

In the event that you have provided personal data to Iberdrola Energía Internacional, you have the right to access your personal data subject to treatment, as well as request the rectification of inaccurate data or, where appropriate, request its deletion when the data is no longer necessary for the purposes that were collected, in addition to exercising the right of opposition and limitation to the treatment and portability of the data.
